- Professor and Senator of the Republic, elected in 2022.
- He was Minister of Justice and Public Security of Brazil from 01/2019 to 04/2020.
- He was a Federal Judge of the 13th Federal Criminal Court of Curitiba/PR, specializing in financial crimes, money laundering and crimes committed by organized criminal groups.
- He worked as an instructing judge at the Federal Supreme Court during 2012.
- He worked as a consultant in the area of compliance and internal corporate investigations for the North American company Alvarez & Marsal.
- He attended the Program of Instruction for Lawyers at Harvard Law School in July 1998 and holds a master's and doctorate degrees in State Law from the Federal University of Paraná - UFPR.
- He has written books and articles specialized in the legal field.
- He participated in the International Visitors Program organized in 2007 by the U.S. Department of State, with visits to U.S. agencies and institutions in charge of preventing and combating money laundering.
- He taught from 2007 to 2016 as Adjunct Professor of Criminal Procedural Law at the Federal University of Paraná - UFPR.
- He is a contracted professor of undergraduate and graduate studies at Unicuritiba - Centro Universitário Curitiba and Uniceub - Centro Universitário de Brasília.
- He received the title of Doctor of Laws, honoris causa, from the University of Notre Dame du Lac, South Bend, Indiana, in 2018, the title of Doctor honoris causa, in 2019, from the University of Marília (Unimar), and the title of Doctor honoris causa, in 2019, from the Centro Universitário Dinâmica das Cataratas – UDC.
